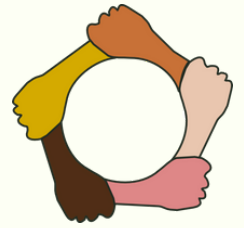

OUR BOYS ARE IN TROUBLE

8 women are murdered in South Africa every day.

62% of children grow up without a father in South Africa.

Siyanqoba began in 2019 after the African Angels community was impacted by the murder of a learner's mother by her partner in January 2019.

Our aim is to change South Africa's current culture of violence and abuse, through small group mentoring for vulnerable boys, helping them to grow into men who live the five honorable values - courage, kindness, self-discipline, honesty and respect.



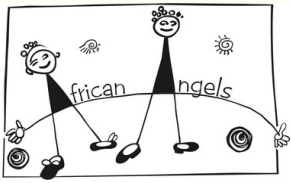
MENTORS ARE VOLUNTEERS

Our volunteer mentors are all members of the Chintsa community, and have agreed to volunteer their time once a week to mentor a small group of boys attending African Angels.

In collaboration with The Character Company, a Johannesburg based Non Profit Organisation, who have 6 years experience in boys to men mentorship, our team will use the The Character Company curriculum and support systems, to help boys at African Angels grow into better men.

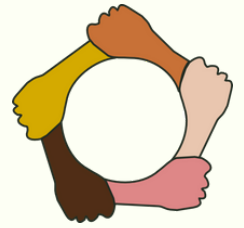
In time we hope to see all boys in Chintsa included in Siyanqoba.





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HOW IT WORKS

LONG TERM MENTORING AND RELATIONSHIP BUILDING

To achieve our goals, we focus on long-term mentoring and relationship building, instilling 5 specific values - courage, kindness, self-discipline, honesty and respect.

We will start working with our boys aged 10 - 14 years, and as more mentors come on board, start working with our younger boys. Our long-term mentorship approach means that we will continue to be part of their lives throughout their school career and beyond.

We have weekly activities for age similar groups of no more than 10 boys at a time.

We continually develop our mentors' skills so they are always growing.

We have various camps throughout the year.

We provide a support structure for parents.

We advocate for the better treatment of women and children.



THE FIVE VALUES

A key part of our mentoring program includes 5 core values which we believe are essential in helping a young boy become a man whose life is guided by the following:

Respect - to treat others and their belongings the way you want to be treated.

Honesty - to tell the truth even when it hurts.

Self Discipline - to do the right thing before someone tells you to.

Courage - to face your fears and conquer them.

Kindness. - to have a good heart.

EACH WEEK WE DISCUSS THESE 5 VALUES WITH EVERY BOY IN THE PROGRAM.

WE TALK ABOUT THEM, WHAT THEY MEAN AND THEN WE LOOK AT PRACTICAL WAYS TO MAKE IT PART OF OUR LIVES.
